



Uniform Guidelines – Years 7-11

1. Pupils must wear full Immanuel College uniform and be modestly dressed, smart and tidy.
2. Boys must wear a kippah at all times.
3. Girls must wear skirts which fully cover the knee. Keep school shirts tucked in and the top button done up.
4. Pupils may not wear trainers unless you have medical reasons explained on a note from a doctor.
5. All pupils must be modestly dressed even on the special occasions on which you are allowed to attend school out of uniform.
6. Pupils may not wear make up or nail varnish.
7. Hair must be of a natural colour, must not be cut in a 'cult'/fashion haircut and girls must wear their hair neatly tied back. Boys may not dye their hair. No one may braid his/her hair.
8. You may wear a watch and one necklace with a religious pendant on it (e.g. Magen David).
9. Girls may wear one pair of stud earrings. Boys may not wear earrings (even if covered up). All other types of earrings, bracelets, necklaces and rings may not be worn for school.
10. Do not bring expensive or sentimental items to school since the school cannot take responsibility for any jewellery.
